

# TALOSSAN OLYMPIC COMMITTEE REGULATIONS



## MAIN CLAUSES

1. Talossan Olympic Committee is a national constituent of the worldwide Olympic movement.
2. Talossan Olympic Committee duties include:
  - a) organizing participation of Talossan athletes in the biannual Olympic Games (once the Kingdom of Talossa becomes a recognized state).
  - b) supporting and developing sports and athletes in the Kingdom of Talossa
  - c) organizing the annual Open Talossalympic Games under the special rulings for Open Talossalympic Games.

## ORGANIZATION

1. Talossan Olympic Committee consists of the Head Commissioner and Committee members.
2. Any member of the Talossan Olympic Committee may call for a election of a new Head Commissioner, if the last elections took place more than six months ago.

## INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC GAMES

1. As of now, the Kingdom of Talossa is an unrecognized state. Once the Talossan Olympic Committee becomes a recognized national OC, it will act accordingly to provide Talossan participation in the Games and other activities in accordance with the Olympic Charter.

## OPEN TALOSSALYMPIC GAMES

1. Since currently Talossan participation in the International Olympic Movement is impossible, in order to preserve the Olympic spirit and overall sports ethics in the Kingdom, Talossa will conduct special Open Talossalympic Games on an annual basis.
2. Open Talossalympic Games are a games organized by the TOC. During the OTG, the teams participate in sports and games, recognized by TOC as Talossalympic, accordingly to this year's OTG program.

3. To register as a participant in the OTG, a team must fall under one of the following categories:

- be a team of athletes/players from one of the provinces of Talossa;
- be a team of athletes/players from a friendly unrecognized state/micronation, if approved by the TOC;
- be a team of athletes/players from a UN recognized state, in which case a certain quota should be preserved, so that the players of such teams did not outnumber Talossan provincial teams or micronational teams.

4. Since, due to the special nature of Talossa, most of Olympic sports are hardly implementable to be played during the OTG, Talossan Olympic Committee forms a separate list of Talossalympic kinds of sports/games. To qualify as a Talossalympic sport/game, a sport/game must be:

- of real nature (e.g. not cybersports per se);
- possible to be played via the Telecomunna (the Internet) unchanged or using a slight change of regulations.

5. Each Talossalympic sport/game must have a special regulatory document, specifying how exactly it should be organized within Talossalympic context.
