Fifth Clark of the 62nd Cosa

1. Results of the May 2026 Clark

As no bills or resolutions have passed both the Cosã and Senãts, Royal Assent is not required.

The Cosã and Senãts both rejected the following bills and resolutions:

62RZ22 – BHAID: Humanitarian Assistance to Sudan Resolution (Reconsideration)
Introduced by Breneir Tzaracomprada (MC-GREEN)
Rejected by the Cosã 64-96 (20 abstained), by the Senãts 0-7 (1 abstained)

62RZ23 – The Sentient Rights Act
Introduced by Breneir Tzaracomprada (MC-GREEN)
Rejected by the Cosã 44-60 (76 abstained), by the Senãts 0-2 (6 abstained)

The Cosã and Senãts disagreed on the following resolution:

62RZ24 – Sense of the Ziu: In Support of Decoloniality
Introduced by Breneir Tzaracomprada (MC-GREEN)
Agreed to by the Cosã 64-20 (96 abstained), rejected by the Senãts 0-0 (8 abstained)

The Cosã passed a Vote of Confidence in the Government 84-25 (71 abstained).

3. Judicial Decisions

The Chancery would like to advise the Ziu that an advisory opinion has been requested by His Majesty King Txec, concerning the ability of the party leader of the Progressive Alliance, the Seneschal, to request him to assign a number of Cosă seats to citizen outside the Progressive Alliance's party list in excess of the limit set by statutory law. The Uppermost Court, through Puisne Judge Sir Istefan Perponest, has indicated it unanimously supports the Seneschal's interpretation of the law, but has yet to render a full opinion as of the publication of this document.

As such, the Chancery will comply with the preliminary announcement but will have to delay publication of the decision, pursuant to Lex.G.12.1, to the next Clark.

4. Prime Dictates

Pursuant to Lex.H.2.7.1, the Chancery announces that no Prime Dictates were issued since the publication of the last Clark.

A. Full text of all Bills on the Clark

62RZ25 – The Freedom of Conscience Act

WHEREAS, Talossa ought to be a nation of laws and principles, as opposed to strongmen and personalities; and

WHEREAS, swearing allegiance to a government appears to conflict with a citizen's Organic right to free expression; and

WHEREAS, swearing allegiance to the nation's constitution is more in line with the ideals of liberal democracy; then

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZIU that Title E, Section 9 of El Lexhatx, which currently reads:

The following text shall be known as The Oath of Talossan Citizenship:

From this day forward, I pledge my loyalty, allegiance, and fidelity to the Kingdom of Talossa and to His Majesty's government. I solemnly affirm that I will support and uphold the Organic Law of the Kingdom of Talossa, defend the realm against all enemies, both foreign and domestic, faithfully observe its laws, respect the rights and freedoms of all my fellow citizens, fulfill all my duties and obligations as a citizen of the Kingdom of Talossa, and humbly appreciate the benefits granted unto me by my King, most especially when those benefits take the form of Talossan currency.

shall be replaced in full with:

The following text shall be known as The Oath of Talossan Citizenship:

From this day forward, I pledge my loyalty, allegiance, and fidelity to the Kingdom of Talossa and to its Organic Law. I solemnly affirm that I will respect the rights and freedoms of all my fellow citizens, faithfully observe the nation's laws, defend the realm against all enemies both foreign and domestic, fulfill all my duties and obligations as a citizen of the Kingdom of Talossa, and humbly appreciate the benefits granted unto me by my King, most especially when those benefits take the form of Talossan currency.
